### ► ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

Footwear – "Dinkles" & Black Socks

- Required black marching shoes that are comfortable & durable
- Black socks are required- keep an extra pair in uniform bag
- Shoe fitting during Band Camp week
  - Estimated cost: \$30
  - Used Dinkles available for \$5 through Boosters
  - Can trade in worn Dinkles for \$5 credit toward a different size (new or used )

#### ► Group Meals

- All members gather for a meal before festivals and some football games
  - Builds camaraderie among the students

  - Consists of main dish, side, fruit, dessert and beverage
