Football Game Experience

At home games, the band performs before the game at 6:30 (kick off at 7pm) and at away games, the band usually performs at halftime. The band gets free time during 3rd quarter and may get food, walk around, etc.

Band Festival Experience

Usually, there is a noon report time at the high school to practice before the festival. Meals are eaten together at L-S (pack or meal plan). Students and equipment are transported to the festivals, and the festivals start around 6:00pm. We will be assigned a performance time. Students will be given a 30-45 minute break during the evening where they may eat dinner (meal plan ticket #5, or \$9 for those not on the meal plan). Candygrams are usually sold at the festivals, where candy and personal sentiments may be purchased for a band member. The last performance is traditionally a college band or all the bands playing together on the field.
